

# Higher Education Report Card (HERC)



## About the Higher Education Report Card

The UC Student Association is the official collective voice of the over 200,000 undergraduate, graduate and professional students in the UC system. The UC Student Association created a Higher Education Report Card this year to hold members of the California State Legislature accountable for legislation that directly impacts students.

## How the Higher Education Report Card works

- UCSA developed a rubric and will continuously track legislators' votes that affect students and produce an annual Report Card that grades legislators on their support of public higher education.
- UCSA uses the Report Card as an education tool to inform students and enable them to lobby, advocate or take action on a legislator's position.

## Explaining HERC

- Legislators receive grades based on a rubric that examines "Yes" and "No" votes on legislation that UCSA has prioritized. Positive scores are given for floor votes on bills that we support, and 0 points if a vote does not reflect UCSA's recommendation. Bills are weighted according to the following formula:

**GRADE = Breadth of student population affected x Depth of impact for that population.**

**BREADTH = {1, 2, 3} corresponds to {Sizeable, Majority, Entire Student Population}**

**DEPTH = {2, 4, 6} corresponds to {Significant, Very Significant, Massive Impact on students}.**

**\*Authorship of bills we support also earns legislators 2 "bonus" points.**

- It is important to note that budget cuts sustained by the UC have had the deepest and widest felt repercussions for students. The 2012-2013 Budget, while not as bad as prior years, included no increases for the UC system and a \$200 million trigger cut. This was unacceptable to students in light of years of devastating cuts. Legislators who voted "correctly" for every single other bill still received a lowered grade due to the intense breadth and depth of the budget bill impact.
- With improved budget projections, students are optimistic that this legislative session will see new opportunities for more student-friendly voting patterns and a budget that reinvests in the UC.
- UCSA encourages legislators to vote with students this year by following the vote recommendations provided on the 2013 Higher Education Report Card Template. We look forward to working with each of our representatives through the Report Card to highlight our true champions of higher education in the State Legislature! We are hoping to see a lot more "A's" on the 2013-2014 Report Card!
